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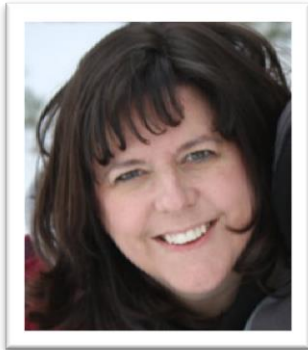

Enrichment Classes

Mrs. Chiappe Passionate Educator



Mrs. Chiappe, an attorney by trade, left the practice of law in 1998 and became a middle school history teacher. She taught in a private K-8 Bay Area school until her family relocated to El Dorado Hills in 2012, where she began the **HISTORY Rocks!** small group history enrichment program.

Mrs. Chiappe has a Bachelor's of Arts Degree in Political Science (including all course work necessary for a Single Subject History Teaching Credential) and a post graduate Juris Doctor Degree. She also is a member of the California State Bar and holds an ACSI Teaching Certification.

American History - Students study the ideas, issues, and events from America's colonial heritage up to World War I.

Founding Documents - Students study the documents that are the basis of the American experience, beginning with the Magna Carta & Mayflower Compact. Particular emphasis is given to the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution.

World History in the Middle Ages - Students study social, cultural, and technological changes that occurred in Europe, Africa, the Americas, and Asia in the years A.D. 500-1789.

History of World Religions - Students will study world history through an examination of the development of various regional religions, such as Christianity in Europe, Islam in the Arab World, Buddhism in Asia, and worship of the Sun god with human sacrifices in Meso-America.

History through hands on Art - Students study and create art from various historical time periods, such as Mosaics from the Roman Empire.

American Cinema - Students study historical events and culture through classic films; such as the Civil War depicted in *Gone with the Wind*.

This is just a sampling of the classes offered, Mrs. Chiappe would be happy to work with you to create a custom course to meet your group's needs.

Class Fees

Fees are approximately **\$60.00 - \$175.00** per session (dependent upon the number of classes; \$10 per class). An additional material fee may be required depending on the projects. Special seminars range between \$10-\$25 dollars per class.
